# 2016 Legislative Agenda as approved at November Board Meeting

- 1. Continue support of House Bill 81, requiring unlicensed ownerbuilders to file a disclosure if they sell a home within 2 years of construction.
- 2. Advocate for funding to CCHRC. Any further reductions in funding could result in this valuable organization disappearing.
- 3. Consider support of Alaska Energy Authority PACE legislation.
- 4. Continue to support a Statewide Residential Building Code with 6 year Code Cycle
- 5. Recommend to AHFC to consider a 6-year Code Cycle
- 6. Advocate for AHFC funding to support the Home Energy Rebate and Low Income Weatherization Programs.
- 7. Support a natural gas pipeline from the North Slope and expansion of transportation infrastructure.
