

Membership – we have a 79.3% retention rate as of August 31^{st} (which is up from the Spring), we have 65 builders, 220 associates for a total of 285 members.

Certified Green Building Class – we offered this three day class in May and 41 of our builders participated to obtain the Green Building Professional designation.

19th Annual Golf Tournament – once again the weather cooperated with us and we had a great day out on the golf course. This event continues to provide our builders with a day to get away from building and have some fun.

44th Annual Parade of Homes – we had the opportunity to showcase the fine work of our builders with 30 entries in this year's August parade. The traffic was steady and up in some homes due the extensive advertising campaign.

Overall Market – currently we have 146 building permits as of July 31st, at the same time last year we had 183. Builders are required to have contracts to build -- no speculative building is taking place. Our values continue to appreciate unlike other markets across the country and our interest rate is still low. We have partnered our advertising dollars with Alaska Housing Finance Corporation in an aggressive advertising campaign to showcase the great things that a new home brings to the Alaskan family.

We are looking forward to hosting the 28th Annual State Convention Nov 12-14th at the Downtown Anchorage Marriott Hotel and seeing all of you in the Fall.
